

## Deer Valley – Scottsdale Thompson Peak Medical Centers PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program

### Deer Valley Medical Center and Department of Pharmacy

Located in Phoenix, Arizona, Deer Valley Medical Center is a 234-bed, not-for-profit community hospital offering Level I trauma care, critical care, and a 24/7 emergency department and pediatric emergency center. Deer Valley Medical Center is an accredited Chest Pain Center and has earned Magnet designation, the highest national designation for excellence in nursing care. The Department of Pharmacy provides 24/7 services, supported by approximately 50 pharmacy personnel. The hospital has a computerized electronic health record, an automated dispensing system, and decentralized clinical pharmacists.

### Scottsdale Thompson Peak Medical Center and Department of Pharmacy

Located north of Loop 101 and Scottsdale Road, Scottsdale Thompson Peak Medical Center is a 120-bed facility offering state-of-the-art medical, surgical, and emergency care services. The hospital provides intensive care services and cardiac care including cardiac catheterization. Scottsdale Thompson Peak Medical Center is a certified Chest Pain Center and has earned Magnet designation, the highest national designation for excellence in nursing care. Additionally, it was awarded the Top Hospital designation by Leapfrog Group in 2015. The Department of Pharmacy provides 24/7 services, supported by approximately 20 pharmacy personnel. The hospital has a computerized electronic health record, an automated dispensing system, and decentralized clinical pharmacy services.

### Residency Program Specifics

The HonorHealth Deer Valley-Scottsdale Thompson Peak Medical Centers PGY1 Pharmacy Residency program is a 12-month full-time, commitment designed to train graduates in the skills needed to become well-rounded and competent clinical pharmacy practitioners. A variety of rotational as well as longitudinal experiences help refine the resident's in-depth knowledge and skills in independent practice.

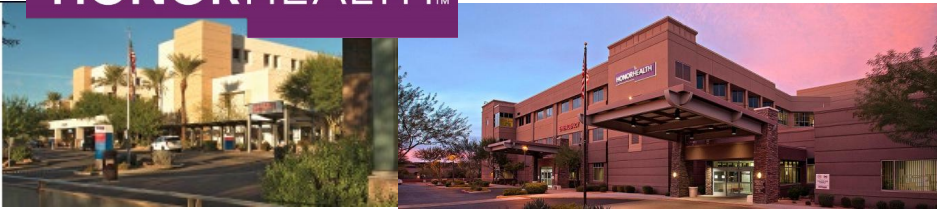

### PGY1 Residency Program Purpose

The HonorHealth Deer Valley – Scottsdale Thompson Peak Medical Centers PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program builds on Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification, and eligible for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

### Requirements for Successful Completion of Residency Program

Upon successful completion of all program requirements and compliance with all conditions of the residency program, HonorHealth Deer Valley – Scottsdale Thompson Peak Medical Centers will award the resident a certificate indicating successful completion of the PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program. Residents who fail to complete all program requirements and comply with all conditions of the residency program will not be awarded a certificate of completion.

### Residency Program Certificate of Completion Checklist\*

  - ACPE-accredited continuing education (CE) presentations for pharmacists and technicians
  - Medication use evaluation (MUE)
  - Drug class review or monograph
  - Drug information papers
  - Practice management project
- Clinician Educators Program (CEP) at Midwestern University College of Pharmacy – Glendale teaching certificate
- Longitudinal residency research project completed
- Residency project manuscript (final) completed and approved by primary preceptor, RPD, and Site Coordinator
- Final evaluation of RPD and overall program submitted

\* RPD and Site Coordinator will meet with each resident to assess completion of the above checklist during the last month of the residency year.
