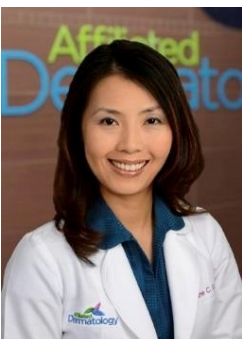
Jason A. Barr, DO Program Director
