PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program

This program is one of the few multi-site residency programs in the state of Arizona. The multi-site program structure allows for a diverse patient population and a variety of learning experiences for the resident. The Osborn Medical Center is a full-service acute-care hospital with 337 medical/surgical beds. The hospital's Level I trauma center is consistently one of the busiest in the state and is regarded as a leader in neuroservices, orthopedics, and rehabilitation.

The Shea Medical Center is known for its oncology, cardiology, and women and children's services. Most recently the oncology service has expanded to support leukemia services, bone marrow transplant, and CAR-T therapy. The Shea campus is also home to HonorHealth Medication Management, an ambulatory care pharmacist-managed clinic.

The Departments of Pharmacy provide 24/7 services supported by approximately 90 pharmacy personnel. The hospitals leverage a computerized electronic health record, automated dispensing systems, IV room verification software, as well as clinical and decentralized pharmacy services.
