The Federal 340B Drug Pricing Program allows qualifying hospitals and clinics treating low-income and uninsured/underinsured patients to buy outpatient prescription drugs at a discount.

- Helps safety-net healthcare providers stretch financial resources to reach more patients.
- Allows healthcare providers to treat vulnerable patients with comprehensive services.

HonorHealth John C. Lincoln Medical Center participates in the 340B federal drug program and utilizes prescription drug savings to make community investments, expand patient care offerings and support vulnerable community members in achieving improved health and well-being.

HonorHealth John C. Lincoln Medical Center's emergency department is a Level I trauma center, which is the highest designation appropriated by the American College of Surgeons.



PATIENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

HonorHealth John C. Lincoln Medical Center provides a large safety-net of care for discharged inpatients and those patients seen in the Emergency Department and other areas. When a need is identified, our Case Management team works with the clinical team and patient to develop a care plan. When a financial barrier exists, the team works to secure services and goods for the patient at no cost, including prescription drugs, durable medical equipment, home health services, home infusion services and placement in an assisted living, group home or skilled nursing facility.
