

SEWER UPGRADE TO AFFECT CAMPUS ACCESSJULY 28-AUG. 1

Phase Three, the construction of Pavilion 3, is well underway. An external traffic restriction is set to begin on Monday, July 28 which will affect patient and visitor access points.

Beginning Monday, July 28, ongoing overnight sewer construction will close two northbound lanes of N. 27th Ave., with restricted access to the southernmost driveway from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. through Wednesday, July 30. Paving of this area will take place from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m. starting Thursday, July 31 through Friday, Aug. 1.

Drivers traveling southbound on N. 27th Avenue will be able to access the southernmost driveway entrance to turn left and enter the campus during construction. City of Phoenix officers will be on site during the construction period to ensure access for emergency vehicles.
