Research, Quality Improvement and Patient Safety

Research, Quality Improvement and Patient Safety (ResQIPS) at HonorHealth is an important aspect of graduate medical education and faculty/preceptor development. It is a comprehensive program dedicated to supporting the scholarly pursuits of residents, fellows, faculty and interprofessional learners across our network.

Through a structured process, residents and fellows receive tailored support, starting with an assessment of their needs, including access to resources such as our medical library and mentorship. Our diverse committee, consisting of experts from multiple fields, provides invaluable support in completing the SQUIRE template, refining research methodologies and navigating Institutional Review Board (IRB) submissions. Through this multidisciplinary approach, we offer insightful feedback and guidance to residents and fellows as they progress through their scholarly endeavors.

Committed to advancing research and patient safety, ResQIPS provides institutional resources such as program coordination, statistical support, mentorship and coordination with the IRB, empowering learners to make meaningful contributions to healthcare quality and safety.

Faculty Development

Programming is designed to contribute to the professional development and advancement of faculty, meet the common program requirements of the ACGME and develop excellent clinical educators

who are prepared for the spectrum of learners they will encounter. Opportunities include workshops, learning on-demand modules, instructional resources, individualized professional development planning, networking, peer collaboration, educational technology and conference attendance.

GME Program Development

We provide affiliation and collaboration to establish new residency and fellowship programs that are aligned with local community needs to address physician workforce shortages.

Clerkship Directors



Peer support model
