

## SEWER UPGRADE TO AFFECT CAMPUS ACCESS OCT. 15-23

An external traffic restriction is set to begin at Deer Valley Medical Center on Wednesday, Oct. 15 which will affect patient, visitor and team member access points.

Beginning Wednesday, Oct. 15, ongoing sewer construction will close the center turning lane, plus one northbound and one southbound lane of N. 27th Ave. Work is scheduled to be completed on Thursday, Oct. 23.

Drivers traveling southbound on N. 27th Avenue will not be able to access the southernmost driveway entrance to turn left and enter the campus during construction. Drivers traveling northbound on N. 27th Avenue will not be able to access the center lane to turn left and enter MOB 2 and MOB 3.

Drivers will need to use the traffic light intersection to access the hospital campus, and northbound drivers will need to U-turn to enter the MOB 2/MOB 3 campus. City of Phoenix officers will be on site during the construction period to ensure access for emergency vehicles.



This upgrade is expected to affect campus accesses from Wednesday, Oct. 15 through Thursday, Oct. 23. Please allow for extra time entering and leaving the campuses during this time.
