

SEWER UPGRADE TO AFFECT CAMPUS ACCESS OCT. 28-NOV. 7

An external traffic restriction is set to begin at Deer Valley Medical Center on Tuesday, Oct. 28 which will affect patient, visitor and team member access points.

Beginning Tuesday, Oct. 28, ongoing sewer construction will create single lane access to the southernmost (main) campus driveway entrance, and close one southbound lane of N. 27th Ave. All drivers will need to proceed through the Emergency Department lower parking area to use the traffic light intersection to exit the hospital.

Work is scheduled to be completed on Friday, Nov. 7.

Exiting through this driveway will be strictly prohibited. City of Phoenix officers will be on site during the main work hours of the construction period to ensure access for emergency vehicles.



This upgrade is expected to affect campus accesses from Tuesday, Oct. 28 through Friday, Nov. 7. Please allow for extra time entering and leaving the campus during this time.
