

SEWER UPGRADE PAVING TO AFFECT CAMPUS ACCESS NOV. 17-19

An external traffic restriction is set to begin at Deer Valley Medical Center on Monday, Nov. 17, which will affect patient, visitor and team member access points.

Beginning Monday, Nov. 17 through Tuesday, Nov. 18, the recent sewer construction at the main driveway entrance will be paved, closing access to the southernmost (main) campus driveway entrance, and restricting one southbound lane of N. 27th Ave. All drivers will need to use the traffic light intersection to enter and exit the hospital, proceeding to the main entrance through the Emergency Department lower parking area.

There will be no access to the southernmost (main) driveway entrance during this period.

Access will be completely closed until Wednesday, Nov. 19, when one lane of the main driveway entrance will reopen. All work is scheduled to be completed by **end of day on Wednesday, Nov. 19**.

Construction flaggers will be on site during work hours of the construction period to ensure access for emergency vehicles and visitors.
