Scottsdale Shea Medical Center

Located in Scottsdale, Arizona, Shea Medical Center is a 427-bed acute care hospital known for its oncology, cardiology, labor and delivery care, and pediatric services. Scottsdale Shea is Level III neonatal intensive care facility and a designated Bariatric Surgery Center of Excellence. Shea Medical Center has also earned Magnet designation, the highest national designation for excellence in nursing care. The Shea campus is home to HonorHealth Medication Management, HonorHealth Cancer Care, and the Virginia G. Piper Surgery Center. The Department of Pharmacy provide 24/7 services with about 50 combined pharmacy personnel including pharmacy specialists and decentralized pharmacy services.

Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center

Located in Scottsdale, Arizona, Osborn Medical Center is a 303-bed acute care hospital known for its neurology, trauma, orthopedic, and critical care services. Scottsdale Osborn is a Level I trauma center and the only Comprehensive Stroke Center in the HonorHealth network. Osborn Medical Center has also earned Magnet designation, the highest national designation for excellence in nursing care. The Osborn campus is home to Greenbaum Surgical Specialty Hospital and to the Family Medicine physician residency program. The Department of Pharmacy provide 24/7 services with about 40 combined pharmacy personnel including pharmacy specialists and decentralized pharmacy services.
