*MSK – musculoskeletal selectives: orthopedics, osteopathic manipulative medicine, rheumatology, or physical medicine & rehabilitation

§ Ambulatory pediatric selectives: pediatric endocrinology, pediatric cardiology, pediatric sports medicine, or ambulatory pediatrics

^ Medicine selectives: cardiology, endocrinology, gastroenterology, pulmonology, hematology/oncology, nephrology, allergy/immunology or neurology

Surgery selectives: trauma surgery, otolaryngology, urology, ophthalmology, podiatry, or hand surgery

ILP based Elective rotations: residents may choose to repeat any required rotation as an elective, choose any 'selective' listed above, or select from the following options: addiction medicine, headache, urgent care, radiology, toxicology, integrative medicine, global health, rural health, hospital medicine, bariatrics, etc. Residents may also request additional electives pending advanced approval. The choice of elective is driven by each residents individualized learning plan and future practice goals.
