Located less than a mile from HonorHealth Deer Valley Hospital, HonorHealth Specialty Pharmacy provides access to high-cost, complex medications used to treat serious chronic conditions. Established in 2017, the specialty pharmacy service line continues to expand its scope of practice by coordinating care closely with HonorHealth specialists and collaborating with healthcare providers both within and outside of the HonorHealth system. Through this integrated approach, the specialty pharmacy supports intensive medication management and ensures seamless communication across the patient's care team.

Pharmacy Services

Our dedicated team of approximately 25 Clinical Pharmacy Specialists deliver comprehensive support that includes side effect management, patient training, education and counseling, 24/7 pharmacist access (including weekends and holidays). Our staff assists with coordination of prior authorizations with providers and insurers, personalized assistance with financial support programs, and free medication delivery. These services are supported by specialized drug handling and education, and the program is distinguished by URAC and ACHC specialty pharmacy accreditation. We are dedicated to fostering the next generation of healthcare professionals with our PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program.
