\*\*\*\*\*\*\*PROFILES/DUTY LIMITING CONDITIONS: Service members with Duty Limiting Conditions and/or Profiles WILL NOT BE accepted for Trauma Training. Pregnant service members who arrive for training will not be scheduled for clinical shifts but will be allowed to participate in classroom activities. \*\*\*\*\*\*\*

CHECKLIST OF ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION: (See document checklist.) Please complete the checklist to register for the HonorHealth Military Partnership Trauma Training/ Readiness Skills Sustainment Training Program. Complete and return the checklist of all required documentation <u>ALONG WITH</u> the associated documents via email to Lportante@honorhealth.com. A confirmation email will be sent upon receipt of all documentation.

**REQUIRED PACKING LIST:** ABUs/ACUs/OCPs are required for four days. Military pin-on name tag (blue or silver in color), pin on rank (regular or subdued), comfortable, closed-toe, closed-heeled athletic shoes that meet military requirements for physical fitness are **mandatory** to wear with the HonorHealth issued scrubs.

FOR ACTIVE DUTY OR NATIONAL GUARD ONLY: Please bring an <u>Alternate Duty Uniform</u> which consists of Navy blue or black polo shirt (unit logo or other small logo is ok), Navy blue, black, or khaki heavy work pants and work or military boots.

**LODGING:** Billeting at one of the local Marriott hotels is highly recommended and they offer a government per diem rate. Contact Natalie Rene at <a href="Natalie.Rene@marriott.com">Natalie.Rene@marriott.com</a>. Luke AFB lodging is not a viable option since it is over 30 miles / more than 1 hour drive time from Honorhealth Osborn Medical Center.

<u>Courtyard Scottsdale Old Town</u>, 3311 N. Scottsdale Road – This is the closest hotel to Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center (approximately 0.2 miles away) and is recommended for Annual Tour.

<u>Scottsdale Old Town Suites</u>, 7325 E Third Avenue - Approximately one mile from Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center.

Residence Inn Scottsdale Paradise Valley, 6040 N. Scottsdale Road - Approximately two miles from Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center. They offer studios and 2-bedroom suites that may decrease per diem costs. Each suite has a full kitchen and other amenities.

**TRANSPORTATION**: Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport is the closest airport to Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center. Commercial ground transportation is available for travel between the airport and hotels mentioned above.

Rental vehicles are <u>required</u> for all participants. Scottsdale Shea Medical Center which is approximately 10 miles north of Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center while Maricopa Integrated Health System is located approximately 10 miles west of Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center. We recommend three rental vehicles for every 10 participants.

ALL dentists, dental techs and/or dental teams will require their own rental vehicles to drive to the Honorhealth Dental Clinics.

**MEALS:** Meals are not provided. They may be purchased at each of the hospitals and in the nearby restaurants.

**MILITARY BEARING**: Remember that you are representing the United States Armed Services during your tour with HonorHealth Military Partnership. Expectations are that all regulations regarding appearance, behavior, and military bearing are followed; e.g. artificial nails are not permitted, colleagues and faculty are addressed by proper titles in a proper manner, etc. Exercise good judgement when selecting off duty activities. Any violation may result in the member being sent home.

**FORCE PROTECTION**: Military personnel are encouraged to maintain situational awareness at all times. Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center is located in an urban environment where crime may occur at any time.

**EMERGENCIES/ILLNESS/INJURIES:** All military personnel in need of medical assistance will be seen at Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center or the closest appropriate emergency room, depending on the severity of the emergency, illness, or injury. Report any medical emergencies, illnesses, or injuries to the HonorHealth Military Partnership administrative staff at 480-882-6577, to your annual training / local chain of command and to the military personnel's home unit.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** Free Wi-Fi is available throughout the HonorHealth hospital system. Office equipment (e.g. copier, fax, email, CAC enabled computers) are available in the Military Partnership administrative office.

**TRAINING CAPACITY**: We can accept <u>up to 8 medics/RNs per course</u>. We definitely appreciate each unit sending the maximum of <u>8</u> medics/RNs per course. Your unit is not required to send ancillary personnel; although we do offer training for specific specialties listed below.

- 1 = 4J0 Physical Therapy Technician
- 1 = 4N1/68D Surgical Technician
- 1 = 4P0 / 68Q Pharmacy Technician
- 1 = 4R0 / 68P Diagnostic Imaging Technician
- 1 = 47G / 63A Dentist (alone or with up to 2 Dental Assistants)
- 1 = 4Y0 / 68E Dental Assistant must be a skill level 5, experience using dental software, rental car required, X-ray certification (preferred), bilingual English & Spanish (optional). Dental Assistant can be sent alone or with a dentist.
