You'll receive your diagnostic exam results at your appointment, and if a biopsy is needed, we'll perform the biopsy within 24 to 48 hours of scheduling the appointment. Test results are typically back in 24 hours. If surgery is required, you can be scheduled to see a breast surgeon.

The Breast Health and Research Center offers low-dose 3D mammography. This allows detection of very small cancers, even in denser breast tissues. This also allows the physicians to be much more confident when ruling tissue cancer free. 3D technology has resulted in a significant decrease in the number of callbacks for follow-up imaging.
